
How NCI data contributes to the whole picture...

How many people are employed?








Participation in integrated employment services varies widely




Individual supported jobs mean hours worked per week










Working in a paid job in the community but would like to work somewhere else










The majority of nonwork services are facility-based



States reporting in all service categories






