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Unweighted, Un-Collapsed and Un-adjusted Data

The data presented below are the *unweighted*, *un-collapsed* and *unadjusted* averages for outcomes from the 2018-19 National Core Indicators In-Person Survey Report. Outcomes are group by domain (that align with Chapters in this report). To read more about collapsing data and risk adjustment see the Methodology section in the NCI History, Activities and Methodology chapter of this report.

The “Average” row is the *average of state averages*.

To protect people’s privacy, **we denote data with “n/a” when fewer than 20 people from a state or residence type responded to a question (though their responses are included in the Average).**

Some of the items are from the face-to-face survey and may be answered only by the person receiving services. Others may have been answered by a proxy respondent (during the face-to-face survey) and some items are drawn from administrative sources. Instances where information may have been collected from a proxy or administrative records are noted in the table titles.
