Demand/Need

By 2020 it is estimated that:

- Almost 700,000 individuals will be receiving services in their family home
- 2 million + direct support workers

 - 1915(i) (10 states CA, CO, CT, FL, ID, IA, LA, MD, NE, OR; DNF KS, MI, RI, VA)
 - 1915(k) (4 states FL, MD, NE, OR; DNF KS, MI, RI, VA)
 - TCM (28 states; DNF KS, MI, VA)
- Non-Medicaid
 - (41 states all but AK, AZ, AR, HI, MS, MT; DNF KS, MI, RI, VA)

HCBS Regulations on Community Living

(1915c, 1915 (i) and 1915(k) effective 3/17/14

Non provider owned

- Integration AND access (Paid work, control resources, typical)
- Choice in where live (Person centered plan, private unit)
- Rights of privacy, dignity and respect; freedom from coercion and restraint.
- Optimize individual initiative, autonomy, and independence
- Choice in service/support and WHO provides them

Provider owned

- Legal enforceable contract
- Privacy
- Locked doors
- Choice in roommates
- Control own schedules, activities and food anytime
- Visitors of choosing anytime































Effect of Intervention via Multi-Level Model

- DSP turnover reduced by 16%
- Intervention Effects
 - See family More likely to "see family whenever they want" (p < .05).</p>
 - Schedule choice More likely to report "choice in deciding their own schedule" (p < .1).</p>
 - Relationships— Higher scale scores, an average of .23 (p < .05).</p>
