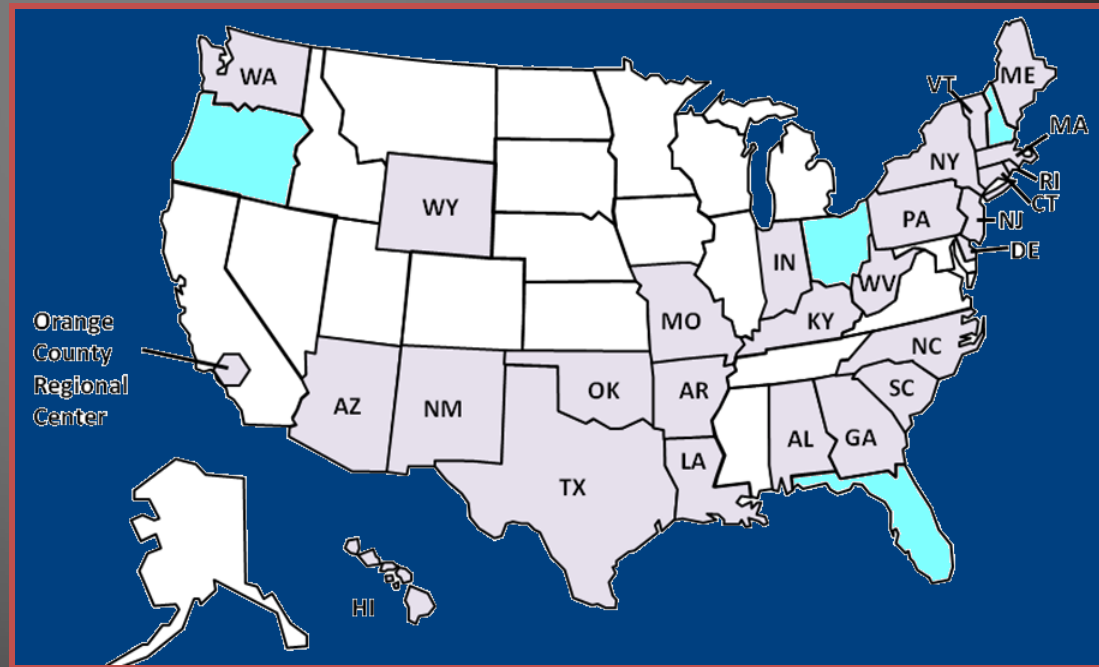
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NCI Vision

- Influence national and state policy
- Improve practice at the state level
- Add knowledge to the field
- Inform the Association's strategic planning and priority setting

National Core Indicators:

- Launched in 1997 in 13 participating states
- Currently 31 states and 4 sub-state regions
- Unparalleled 10-year database on over 12,000 individuals

NCI Data Sources

- Consumer Survey (in person interviews)
- Family Survey (mail-in)
 - ❖ Adult Family Survey (at home, 18+)
 - ❖ Family Guardian Survey (out-of-home)
 - ❖ Children Family Survey (at home, <18)
- Provider Survey
 - ❖ Staff Stability
 - ❖ Board Representation
- System Data
 - ❖ Incidents
 - ❖ Mortality



National Core Indicators Measures Offer a Unique View

- Individual characteristics
- The locations where people live
- The activities they engage in during the day
- The nature of their **experiences** with the supports that they receive
