Independent Monitoring for Quality (IM4Q)





Survey Administration

- Administrative Entities (AEs)
 - individual counties
 - joinders (two or more smaller counties which share administrative duties)
- IM4Q Local Programs
 - Independent organizations
 - Free from conflicts of interest
 - May contract with multiple AEs
- IM4Q Monitoring Teams
 - Usually 2 monitors per team
 - At least 1 person on the team is a person with a disability or a family member of a person with a disability



•ODP requests randomly-drawn samples for each AE from the Home and Community Services Information System (HCSIS) and provides them to the AEs

• AEs and IM4Q local programs eliminate names which do not meet the sampling criteria

 Local programs contact the people included in the samples to ask if the person is willing to participate in an interview, and if so, to schedule it

#3. Increase Employment

- People who have a paid job in the community
 - averaged 13% over the three years
- People who would like a paid job in the community
 37-38% then dropped to 31% in the third year
- People who want to work and have an employment goal in their Individual Support Plans
 - Averaged 24% over the three years



<u>#4. Support Families Throughout the Lifespan</u>

•Family Members Who Receive Information to Help Plan Services

- 73-74% reported always or usually receiving information in the first two years, but increased to 79% in the third year
- An average of 15% reported sometimes receiving information
- 10% reported seldom or never receiving information in the first two years, but decreased to 7% in the third year



<u>#5. Promote Health, Wellness, and Safety</u>

- •Individuals and Self-Advocates Who Exercise monthly
 - An average of 36% reported that they who never go out for exercise
 - An average of 19% reported that they exercise once/week or less
 - An average 46% reported that they exercise more than once/week



#10. Expand Options for Community Living

- Individuals and Self-Advocates Who Chose Their Home
 - An average of 33% reported that they made their own choice (25%-46%)
 - An average of 33% reported that they had some input in choosing (25%-44%)
 - An average of 33% reported that someone else made the choice 25%-49)
