### National Core Indicators

The National Core Indicators (NCI) is a national survey used by developmental disabilities agencies to evaluate the outcomes of services provided to individuals and families. It is used in 46 states including Michigan.

### Key Areas of Concern

- Employment
- Rights
- Service planning
- Community inclusion
- Choice
- Health

### Michigan

38,000 individual's with Intellectual and/or developmental disabilities receive services from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS).

In 2016, 435 of those individuals were randomly selected to complete the NCI survey.

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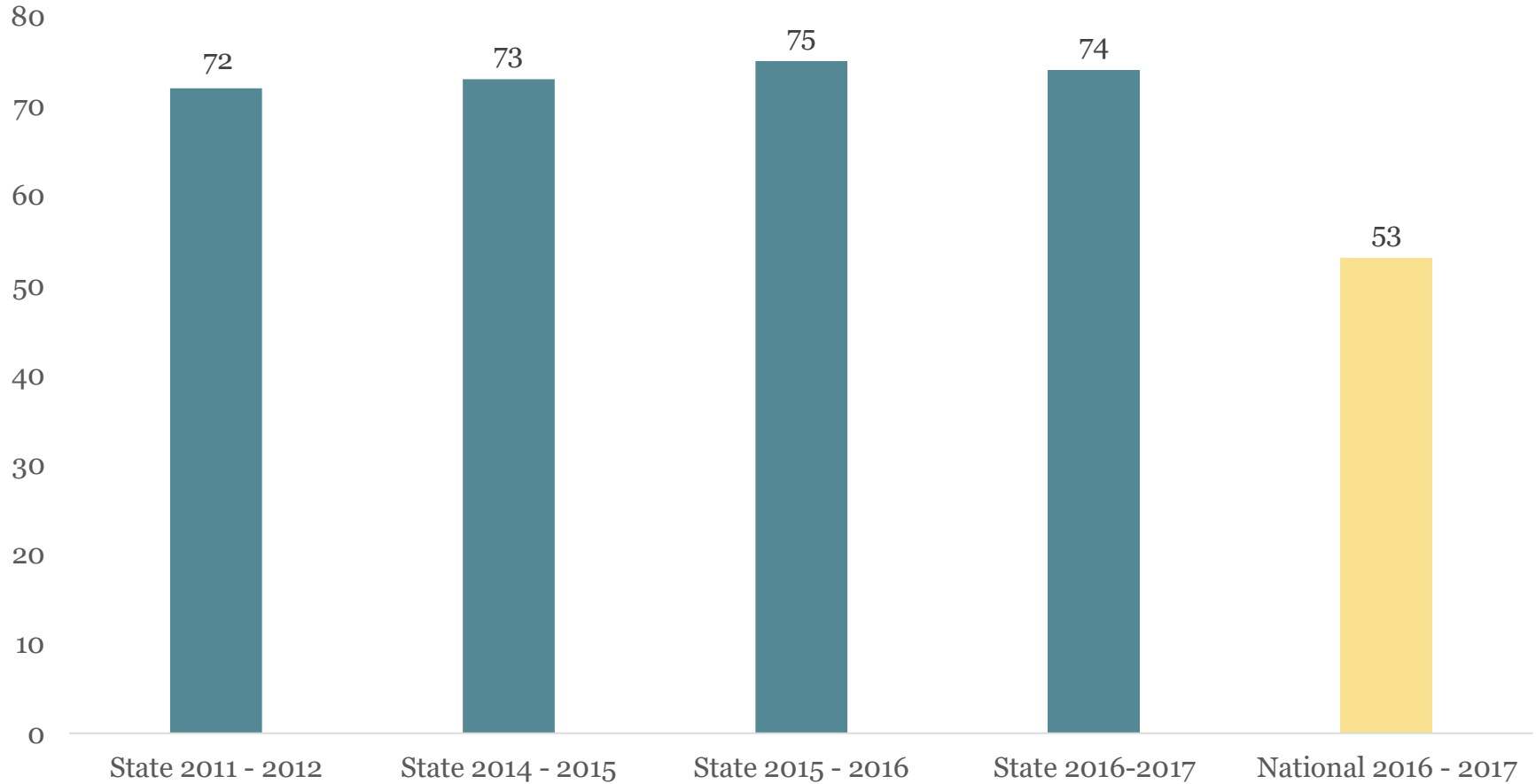

# Michigan Considerations for Using NCI Data

- 1. Supported Decision Making**-because of the high rates of guardianship in Michigan, the DD Council developed a Supported Decision Making project to train people around the state to use SDM in the daily lives of people with IDD
- 2. Home and Community Based Services**-developing a crosswalk between NCI and HCBS variables to validate data
- 3. Community of Practice**-analyzing NCI data to inform Michigan's CoP on cultural and linguistic competence in service delivery
